Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter reserves its rights to recover damages or other compensation from any person that does not comply with these Conditions of Entry.
