	<p>scrutineer (“Draw”). All valid entries received during the Promotional Period will be entered into the draw. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn.</p>
Prizes	<p>MAJOR PRIZE</p> <p>6. The first valid entry drawn will win that entrant (“Participant”) the opportunity to play a contingency game (“the Game”) for the chance to win a choice of either AU\$160,000 cash or a RAM 1500 Laramie Sport valued at up to AU\$160,000 (“Vehicle”) (both referred to as the “Major Prize”).
